- In 2016, no project applications were received
 - ► New rules for Ffl developed:

allow for bigger projects open it up for PhD activities CASEE Secretariat offers support to find FfI-partners

New call will be published in December to fund 2 projects à 8.000 € (= budget 2016 + 2017) application deadline appx. 1st March (tbc)



4. Changes in the membership

1. Cancellation of membership:

- * Corvinus University Budapest
- * Warsaw University of Technology
- 2. No institutions are due to being suspended for non-payment of fees
- 3. New members since 2016:
 - * University of Sarajevo, Bosnia-Herzegovina
- 4. Decision on CASEE conference fees for CASEE members of the countries that do only pay half of the CASEE membership fee:
- Should only pay half of the registration fee for a CASEE member but limited to a maximum of 5 persons per Member university
